WE ARE COMMITTED TO 3 CAPITALS, INSISTS SAJJALA

VIJAYAWADA

GOVERNMENT advisor (public affairs) and YSRCP general secretary Sajjala Ramakrishna Reddy on Wednesday clarified that the government remained committed to its policy of three state capitals.

He alleged that the opposition TDP is creating confusion among people over the state capital.

The clarification came after finance minister Buggana Rajendranath Reddy's statement about the state capital.

Ramakrishna Reddy claimed that Rajendranath Reddy only reiterated the government's stand but "the TDP's friendly" media distorted his statement. At a road show held in Bengaluru on Tuesday as part of the Global Investment Summit Vizag campaign, Rajendranath Reddy said that there is a lot of miscommunication on the issue of state capital. He told the investors that the state government was committed to starting the rule from Visakhapatnam.

The finance minister also stated that the YSRCP government has decided on Visakhapatnam as the next capital of Andhra Pradesh.

"That Andhra Pradesh has three capitals is completely wrong," he was quoted as saying.

As for Kurnool as the judicial capital, Rajendranath Reddy said that Kurnool is not the capital, but the Principal Bench of the High Court would be set up there. He further stated that it was the government's decision to hold Assembly sessions in Guntur district (Amaravati).

However, a day after the finance minister's statement, Ramakrishna Reddy made it clear that the YSRCP government headed by Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy is committed to development of all regions of the state.

He told reporters at the state Secretariat that the government has already declared that Visakhapatnam will be the administrative capital

while Amaravati will be the legislative capital and Kurnool will be developed as judicial capital.

"We remain committed to our policy of decentralisation of governance," he said and alleged that the opposition TDP and its "friendly media" are creating confusion among people.

"Not a bench but the entire High Court will come up in Kurnool," he said when asked about the finance minister's statement. "I don't know in which context he made the statement," he remarked.

Claiming that some elements were making claims for real estate business, the government advisor called on people not to get misled by their false propaganda. Some people are deliberately spreading misinformation, he said.

Ramakrishna Reddy said that the YSRCP government will not indulge in politics over state capitals for elections. "We don't say one thing during the election and another thing after elections," he said.

The advisor recalled that Sivaramakrishna Committee had recommended decentralisation of power and slammed TDP president and former chief minister N Chandrababu Naidu for missing an opportunity.

The YSRCP leader said Chandrababu Naidu had estimated that development of Amaravati as the state capital will cost Rs 1 lakh crore and since the government is not in a position to bear this expenditure, it decided to go for decentralised development with three state capitals.

HC stays notice to employees' body

ANDHRA Pradesh High Court on Wednesday granted stay on the show-cause notice issued by the state government to leaders of the AP Government Employees Association (APGEA) for meeting state Governor to seek his intervention to ensure payment of salaries and pensions on time.

Hearing a petition filed by APGEA leaders challenging the show-cause notice, Justice Ravinath Tilahari granted a stay and directed the government to file a counter.

A delegation of APGEA leaders led by its president K R Suryanarayana had met Governor Biswabhusan Harichandan on January 19 and submitted a memorandum to him on the problems faced by the employees.

The delegation requested the Governor to issue necessary advice to the government as he is competent authority as per the Article 309 of the Constitution to intervene in the affairs of the government employees.

After the meeting, APGEA leaders told media persons that they were compelled to meet the Governor as all their efforts to resolve the grievances through the state government had failed.

However, taking a serious note of the action of APGEA leaders, the government had issued a show-cause notice on January 23 asking them to explain why their association should

told the court that according to the 1990 Financial Code, salaries to government employees should be paid on the last working day of every month but employees are not getting current month salaries till 15th of next month.

Suryanarayana alleged that the state government is not honouring the commitment to pay the salaries and pensions on the first of every month. The APGEA leader said the government also withdrew the GPF amount of Rs 415 crore from the accounts of over 90,000 employees without their permission. He termed this a "serious" financial fraud. PD ACT INVOKED AGAINST TWO GANJA PEDDLERS

RACHAKONDA Commissioner D S Chauhan invoked a Preventive Detention (PD) Act on two interstate drug peddlers on Wednesday and were detained. Police seized 551 kg of ganja from them.

According to police, the inter-state drug offenders hailing from Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh with their headquarters in Mumbai have been procuring ganja in huge quantities from Nidudvulu, Andhra Pradesh.

Nagaraj, one of the accused from Tamil Nadu heads the drug racket and has been procuring ganja from Kimmudu Narsing Rao and Shaik Mohammed, both accused from AP. "The drugs were purchased at a cheaper rate and were transported in a DCM van through Nagaraj's driver Venkatesh to Mumbai City. From there, Nagaraj distributes ganja to prospective customers in the neighboring states as per demand. Nagaraj pays Rs 1,50,000 to Venkatesh for each trip he makes," said a senior police officer. On receiving information, the Special Operations Team along with Hayath Nagar Police intercepted a DCM vehicle at Pedda Amberpet and arrested the accused Venkatesh on Wednesday.

BRS alleges 'discrimination' by Election Commission

ALLEGING discrimination, the BRS on Wednesday said that while the Election Commission allowed Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Jaganmohan Reddy to inaugurate the steel factory in Kadapa, it denied permission to declare open new Secretariat in Telangana.

Addressing a press conference here at Telangana Bhavan, Animal Husbandry Minister Talasani Srinivas Yadav said Reddy was allowed to go ahead with the inauguration of the steel factory even though the model code was in force, but not for the Secretariat.

He said the Opposition leaders were unable to digest development taking place in the State and also the new Secretariat. "How can the commission deny permission here and allow there."

Furniture warehouse gutted in massive fire

IN yet another fire incident in the city, a furniture godown in the Puranapuri area was gutted in a major fire on Wednesday.

As many as seven fire tenders after fighting for more than four hours the fire was doused.

No casualties were reported in the fire accident, but a thick blaze and smoke sent panic among people and forced the authorities to vacate residents from the surrounding houses to the safer zone.

Upon observing smoke billowing from the godown, locals immediately alerted the police control room. On information fire tenders rushed to the spot. And later the fire tender from Jubilee Hills was also joined the fight against the fire. "With total seven fire



engines were pressed into service to control the fire which was raging even after three hours. The roof was also collapsed due to the massive fire," said a senior officer.

Fire services personnel pulled down

the walls of the warehouse with bulldozers and the debris was collected and was dumped. The godown is believed to have been used for storing decorative items, and the exact cause of the fire is yet to be ascertained. The owner of the warehouse is said to be absconding. Police registered a case and took up investigation.

One more minor fire accident occurred in the plastic scrap godown at Jalpally under Balapur mandal at around 6.30 pm. The fire tenders from Maheshwaram and Rajendra Nagar rushed to the spot and controlled the fire.

Following the series of fire accidents, authorities have warned that strict action would be taken against the owners of commercial buildings and warehouses not taking adequate fire safety measures and also against those running their operations in residential areas.
